

# No Man's Land Gold



**Category:** Dry Red Wine

**Alcohol :** 14% alc. by vol.

**Grape variety:** 75% Merlot & 25% Cabernet

**Producer:** Damianitza Winery , Bulgaria

The 5-mile strip of land between Bulgaria's primary border and the main frontier with its southern neighbors -- a narrow strip of land, which previously separated the worlds of Socialism and Capitalism -- is an environmental paradise, pollution-free with preserved wildlife. The vines here bask in the sun, producing succulent and rich fruit. The first No Man's Land red vintage was born in 1998 in the vineyards thriving in the virgin 'no man's land' strip between the state borders.

The grapes came from selected vineyards in South Western Bulgaria. They were hand picked and transported in crates. Prior to processing, a secondary selection was carried out to choose the best bunches. The wine has a fresh character, which is typical for this vintage.

The vinification was made with slow extraction during the prolonged skin contact. 75 % of the wine was aged in French and Bulgarian oak barrels for 10 month.
